PROPOSITION 5

Shall the Lonedell R-XIV School District of Franklin County, Missouri issue general obligation bonds in the amount of Three Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$3,750,000) for the purpose of constructing, improving, expanding, renovating and furnishing the District's campus, including but not limited to (1) construction of a bus garage, parking lot expansion and improvements, safety and security improvements throughout the campus, playground and recreation improvements and roof repair or replacement, and (2) the acquisition of buses and vehicles for the District, resulting in no estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the school district is estimated to remain unchanged at the current levy of \$0.6662 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
