GASCONADE COUNTY R-I SCHOOL DISTRICT

PROPOSITION C.A.R.E.

Shall the Board of Education of the Gasconade County R-1 School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to replace the High School roof; to complete tuckpointing; to repave parking lots; to replace the remaining heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6030 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
