MERAMEC VALLEY R-III SCHOOL DISTRICT

PROPOSITION 5

Shall the Board of Education of the Meramec Valley R-III School District of Franklin, St. Louis and Jefferson Counties, Pacific, Missouri, issue general obligation bonds in the amount of \$43,000,000 for the purpose of renovating, expanding, improving, acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping school buildings, sites and facilities, including the construction of a new middle school with storm shelter and athletic facility improvements, the acquisition and installation of technology infrastructure and equipment upgrades, safety and security improvements, and energy efficiency improvements? If this proposition is approved, the debt service levy of the school district is estimated to remain unchanged from the current debt service levy of \$0.95 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
